1. It is understood that all the students of Mysore Public School, Mysore, are strictly forbidden from smoking, consuming of alcohol & possession of drugs, and possession of unauthorised cash, and that the school reserve the right to expel my ward at any time, including the final external examination period if he / she is found guilty of any such offence.
2. It is further understood that the School reserves the right to expel my ward any time including the final external examination period for including in any act of misconduct / indiscipline involving any other students.
3. The School will not be held responsible for any injury suffered by my ward of for his / her loss of life during activities such as games, sports, gymnastics, mountaineering, expedition and camping.
4. I hereby give my consent for any emergency surgery, if necessary, to be performed on my ward and declare that the School authorities will not be held responsible for any adverse consequences thereof.
5. The final external examination certificate of my ward should be collected from the School personally by the Father / Mother / Guardian, as the case may be, and not by any authorised or otherwise person.
6. The School reserves the right to strike the name of my ward off the Rolls or stop him / her from appearing for any examinations including external examination for non-payment of fees and other dues before the commencement of such examinations.
7. The School will not undertake the travel arrangements for my ward if the requisition for the same is made after the date stipulated in the School circulars / calendar / diary.
8. I understand that a fine of Rs.500/-(five hundred only) will be levied per child per day for late reporting after the Summer & Winter vacations, and after the mid-term breaks in October & March, the relevant dates of which are stated in the School diary / calendar / and circulars sent beforehand.
9. The Transfer Certificate will be issued if the child reports after SEVEN days, without prior written permission, and without valid documents. The School reserves the right to reject any false documents.
